Clos Montmartre

The very last vineyard in Paris. Produces 2000 bottles of pure parisian wine. It's worth to see vineyard just in the middle of haussmannian style buildings.

Parc des Buttes Chaumont

Very nice and calm place perfect for relax after busy day in Paris. There is a tower in the middle where you can climb up and see Sacre Coeur and beautiful perpective of roofs of Paris.

Sacre Coeur & Montmartre

Galleries Lafayette
